DIRECTOR/ DRAMTURGY NOTES

The Harvest Director's Note

The world we live in now can feel harsh and confusing. Humans are always finding ways to navigate the big questions. Luckily, there are a lot of ways to navigate its difficulties. For some, Religion becomes a means of peace and asylum. For others, the theater becomes a place of worship with the script and community at its center. In a society constantly being berated with bad news, we must hold closely what gives us comfort, while releasing judgment for ways of coping perhaps we don't understand. Samuel D Hunter's writing encourages us to contemplate the nature of devotion; how sowing seeds of connection, tolerance, and empathy might guide us towards peace. The creation of this play helped us to realize there are many shapes that devotion can take; As you witness our story today, we hope you'll be inspired to reflect on what you are devoted to, and how that devotion helps you survive.

Our characters live in a world on the edge of transition. Idaho Falls will soon become a distant memory, and a daunting future in the Middle East will prevail. But with faith in the future and belief in the goodness of the work, our story keeps persevering. Galatians 6:7–10. Tells us to "not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time, we will reap a harvest of blessings if we don't give up. Therefore, whenever we have the opportunity, we should do good to everyone-especially to those in <u>faith of faith".</u>

Anna in the Tropics Program Note

There are many ways to measure the passage of time. I invite you to think about how you measure time in your own life — by calendar invites? Class times? Song lengths? When in your life do you allow time to slow down?

A quality cigar will burn for about an hour, allowing its recipient to truly sit and enjoy its pleasures. Someone who values the long smoke of a cigar will measure time passing through the cigar's longevity. Our playwright Nilo Cruz speaks of the escape that becomes possible while smoking a cigar. How are we changed when we slow down to experience the world in this way? Our characters, engaged in the process of making cigars, also find a means of escape through the stories they are read. That sense of escapism is an imperative part of this world. It begs the question: where do you escape to? To the wintery wonderland of Tolstoy's Russia, to the future where power is yours, or to the lover you can't have?

Our characters are living in a world that is on the brink of transition. Soon after, their world will transition into our world: cigars will make way for cigarettes, workers will be replaced by machines, and lectors and their stories will disappear from the factories. As you watch the play today, we invite you to experience time at the pace our characters do — in chapters heard, in cigars rolled, and in waiting for a lover.
